

Hiking in Majorca

to

Alaró

Experience a feeling of inner freedom and love of nature.

Walking route:

The walk starts at the station of Binissalem. It is a small village in the inland from Majorca, which is far known beyond the island for its wine. On the train route from Palma it lies before the town of Inca.

We cross the railway, to travel lightly straight, and see the extraordinary silhouettes from the hill *Puig d'Alaró* and its twin hill *Puig d'Alcadena*. The trail will be narrower and we go on stony paths through a small grove up to the hill *Bellveure* (beautiful view).

Here we can enjoy the almost untouched nature, hear the animals and watch the birds on their flights high above the landscape.

On the other side of the hill we go down to the lovely valley of Alaró and are accompanied by almond trees, sheeps, pigs and chickens of the farms. At the end we reach the romantic village Alaró and we make a stop there for a lunch.

We take the bus back to Binissalem Station.

Duration: Walking time: about 3 hours.

Total: about 6 hours with breaks and including restaurant.

Level of difficulty: Easy, altitude difference: 120m.

Recommended for families (baby in backpacks, children over 5 years).

Equipment: Sports- or hiking boots, sun protection (hat, glasses, lotion for sun protection),

rain gear, water to drink and sandwiches for a picnic.

In Alaró we will have lunch in a typical Majorcan restaurant.

Meeting point: At the train station of Binissalem.

To reach by train or car.
