## Immerse into the free and creative atmosphere of this small and unique village

## Walking tour:

Deiá is located on the north west coast, close to the shore in the Serra de Tramuntana, on the coastal road Ma-10.

It has always been a village for artists.

Deiá was the chosen home of the famous English writer Robert Graves († 1985). He worked and lived there with his family. We will visit his house with garden, the place of inspiration for many of his works. We also visit other ateliers of contemporary artists and potteries.

We also go the flower-adorned Way of the Cross through the old village up to the chapel and the cemetery, which is famous for its exceptional location and its views of the sea and the mountains. We will have time to stroll in this special place and to eat something for lunch at a Majorcan restaurant (Menu: 15 €.)

**Duration:** Walking time: about 2.5 to 3 hours

Total: a whole day, about 7 hours with breaks, strolls and including restaurant.

**Level of difficulty:** 

Recommended for families (baby in backpacks, children over 5 years).

**Equipment:** Sport shoes, sun protection (hat, glasses, lotion for sun protection), rain gear,

water to drink and sandwiches for a picnic.

In Dejá we will eat in a typical Majorcan restaurant.

**Meeting point:** At the bus stop of Deiá, bus No. 210.

To reach by bus or car, parking places are rare.
